It was a unique transformation of an existing 3 season porch into that of a 4 season veranda designed to be a relaxing get-a-way without ever have to leave home. A combination of "old school" (vaulted ceilings and exposed beams) and "new school" (wirelessly controlled LED "up lighting" and radiant heated flooring) made for a perfect blend and level of sophistication to satisfy any homeowner. The homeowners required a certain flow so that "the project must look like it was never added on." Custom windows, custom doors and exposed beams (made from reclaimed timber shipped all the way from Pennsylvania) were all on the list of the owner's specific needs. The landscaping could not be disturbed, so naturally, a custom "catwalk" was designed and built to accommodate the request.
